## Course objectives:

The course further develops grammatical knowledge and uses technical texts for practice. The course is directed from passive knowledge to teaching active speech. It develops vocabulary in the field of study and with the increasing higher difficulty of texts leads the students to better understanding and ability to summarize texts.

## Requirements on student

Input: knowledge of English at ANGM1 level.

Output: Condition for obtaining credit is to earn at least 220 points out of total 340 points.

The points can be earned:

1. In three tests which verify knowledge of grammar and reading with comprehension.

The tests will be written in 4th, 8th a 13th week of the semester. Maximum number of points in each test: T1 40 points, T2 40 points a T3 160 points.

## Content

1 - 2. Present perfect simple and continuous tenses (active and passive form). Adverbs. Time expressions. Phrasal verbs.

Adjectives. Prepositions with nouns.

3 - 4. Gerund. Verb patterns: verb + -ing, verb + to + infinitive, verb + infinitive

5 - 6. Zero, first, second and third conditional. Phrasal verbs. Nouns. Articles. Pronouns, each other.

7. Modal verbs: expression of probability in the present and past.

Word formation. Adjective and preposition.

8-9. Indirect question. Formal and informal letters.

10-11. Indirect speech. Question tags. Phrasal verbs.

12. Revision

13. Final test.

Reading and discussing texts related to the students' field of study is part of each lesson.
